



Scholarship Commitment Letter

Memorial Youth Flight Training Scholarship



This document describes the responsibilities committed to by Cascade Warbirds and the recipient and parent/guardian, if applicable, ("recipient") of the Cascade Warbirds Memorial Youth Flight Training Scholarship. Sign and return this to accept the scholarship.

Please ensure you are aware of the commitment flight training requires in terms of time, dedication, and money. Consistency and frequency of training, ideally more than once per week, will accelerate progress and reduce cost. You will need to choose a flight school partnered with Cascade Warbirds—research the options listed on our [website](#). Proximity is as important to regular training as a good personality match with your flight instructor (CFI).

Cascade Warbirds commitments

Payments will be made as arranged with the flight school and recipient, either directly to the flight school or as reimbursement to the recipient upon submission of an invoice for the listed training milestone. Payments will be made within 30 days of receipt of invoice.

- Pay for (one) ground school registration
- Pay for (one) set of ground school training materials (as required by the school)
- Pay for first covered instructional flight
- Pay for second covered instructional flight
- Assign as a mentor a Cascade Warbirds member who is an FAA certificated pilot

Recipient commitments

Completion of training milestones will be confirmed by submission of documentation for each to the Cascade Warbirds mentor. Ground school and instructional flights will be conducted through a flight school approved by Cascade Warbirds. The covered flights are scheduled at the discretion of the flight school, either during or after completion of ground school.

- Accept the scholarship
 - How: Attend the March or April meeting of Cascade Warbirds (normally on the second Saturday at the Museum of Flight; check www.cascadewarbirds.org/events for updates). Speak with the scholarship committee chair if you cannot attend.
 - Submit: This signed document
 - Due by: 1 month from notification of award

Complete ground school

- Submit: Course completion certificate or logbook entry by CFI
- Due by: End of scholarship issue calendar year

Complete first covered instructional flight

- Submit: Logbook entry by CFI
- Due by: End of scholarship issue calendar year

Complete second covered instructional flight

- Submit: Logbook entry by CFI
- Due by: End of scholarship issue calendar year

Check in monthly with your Cascade Warbirds mentor (through completion of second covered instructional flight)

- Submit: Brief summary of training progress
- Due by: End of each month from acceptance of scholarship

Recommendations

Use your Cascade Warbirds pilot mentor! These are experienced pilots with backgrounds ranging from private to airline to military, propeller to jet, local to global. They will happily talk about opportunities in aviation and assist with training questions (use your instructors for official guidance). *If you are under age 18, your parent or legal guardian should set guidelines for how you and your mentor communicate.*

If unforeseen circumstances arise that affect your ability to progress in your training, please contact your Cascade Warbirds mentor. We want you to succeed and our scholarship committee will work with you to find a path forward.
